# GOOD EVENING LADIES AND GENTLEMEN AND WELCOME TO WEST END BARES 2017 RUBY STRIPPERS.

Sparkly shoes take over from the legends of Camelot as David Grewcock and the amazing team behind "Excalibare", last year's sell out West End Bares, bring you "Ruby Strippers". In 2009, following discussions with Jerry Mitchell, the creator of Broadway Bares, TheatreMAD produced its very first West End Bares: Strip Britannia. The show has gone from strength to strength and following another sell-out year at the Café de Paris in 2015 we moved to our new home, the Novello theatre last year where the evening proved to be a huge success. So here we are once again for our 8th West End Bares.

As well as having a fantastic evening of fun and frivolity, I hope you will all take a moment to reflect on why the Make A Difference Trust and all of our wonderful volunteers work so hard to continue to raise funds for HIV/AIDS. For those of you who aren't familiar with the MAD Trust, we have been raising funds for HIV/AIDS for nearly 30 years. All the funds we raise are through the generosity of time, spirt and talent of the theatre industry. Everyone who is involved in our events from make-up artists to dancers, lighting designers to directors all give their time as volunteers. To support those who support TheatreMAD, we have set up our new peer support programme for those in the theatre industry living with HIV.

There are over 100,000 people living with HIV in the UK. In some areas, as many as 1 in 6 are unaware of their status. The proportion of new diagnoses reported in people born in the UK has increased from 35% to 44%.

We work with our partners both in the UK and Sub-Saharan Africa on HIV projects that build awareness, provide care, support and education.

This autumn has seen our education through theatre programme performed in drama schools across London, informing and educating young people about the virus and its impact. The success of the project was summed up by the comment of one of the students: "thank you for turning a taboo subject into a conversation." We hope to continue and extend the programme so that it will become a part of the timetable in all drama schools.

There are 36.7 million people living with HIV worldwide. Sub-Saharan Africa remains most severely affected, with nearly 1 in every 25 adults. We continue to work with our partners in Sub-Saharan Africa to provided education and support for children living with or affected by HIV

For the MAD Trust, raising awareness and education, particularly for young people, is a key to a better understanding of HIV; understanding its impact on individuals, understanding the stigma and prejudice that can be encountered, and understanding the importance of testing and early diagnosis.

All of the work we do is only made possible by the continued support and commitment of all the wonderful people from the theatre industry; so to everyone who has helped to make this evening possible we would like to say a massive thank you. I would like to welcome each and every one of you to tonight's show. Welcome to those of you who are new to West End Bares, and to those of you who are returning, welcome back. By being here tonight, we are all one step closer to making a difference.

Have a wonderful, glitzy, glamour filled evening, and thank you for helping us make a difference to people's lives.







The Make a Difference Trust – TheatreMAD, was founded in 2008, establishing the first official stand-alone charity to coordinate the theatre community's fundraising and grant making for HIV and AIDS.

A host of fundraising events including Bucket Collections, Late Night Cabarets, West End Eurovision, A West End Christmas, A MAD Drag Night and West End Bares continue to raise funds for projects both in the UK and Sub-Saharan Africa.

In recognition of the theatre industry's long-term fundraising efforts, MAD is launching a peer mentoring programme for those in the theatre industry who are living with HIV. This is being launched under the West End Cares umbrella. For those of you who have been with us from the beginning of our fundraising efforts almost 30 years ago, the name will be familiar.

Over the many years of MAD fundraising, one thing that stands out is the incredible generosity and humanity of the theatre community. Over and over they give their precious time to help others. TheatreMAD has a long history of raising funds through our events and a wealth of expertise which we would like to share. Whilst we are and will always be a HIV & AIDS charity, we have now extended our offer so that we can share all this experience with the theatre community. Anyone in the theatre community who wishes to put on a benefit to respond to emergencies or disasters such as the Manchester Arena attack, or Grenfell Tower disaster for example, or indeed to support a friend in the industry who finds themselves in dire need, we will be able to offer our knowledge and resources to support their event.

MAD Trust's philosophy is all about the theatre community making a difference by working together, using their skills and talents to help other communities living with, or affected by HIV and AIDS.

Today, as a fundraising and grant making organisation, the Trust is building on a legacy of 25 years to raise funds for HIV and AIDS projects that build awareness, deliver education about how to prevent transmission, encourage early testing and provide care and support to those affected by HIV, both in the UK and Sub-Saharan Africa.

The Trust continues to work with established partners to ensure projects have maximum impact and are sustainable. The Trust has distributed over £1.6 million in grants to support individuals experiencing hardship across the UK, as well as over £1 million to support projects with our UK and International partners.

Positive East has been on the forefront of HIV service and care for over 25 years; supporting people from point of HIV diagnosis to longer term care. Guided by our mission - to improve the quality of life of individuals and communities affected by HIV – we have developed a holistic range of health and wellbeing programmes from counselling to workshops to HIV testing and prevention; we do instant HIV tests in more places than anyone else.

All activities aim to increase wellbeing, self-esteem, community integration, confidence, medical adherence and optimism and make a direct and tangible impact in the lives of people living with HIV.

We support the Re:Assure Women's Project - a specialist programme that is targeted to, and tailored for, HIV positive women who are in crisis and have experienced, or are living in, environments of domestic violence, are survivors of abuse and severe trauma, e.g. rape and forced marriage and those who are refugees or asylum seekers. Over a year, 150 women will participate in, and benefit from Re:Assure.

The Make a Difference Trust has contributed to the funding of an incredibly exciting new project to take collaboration between specialist HIV community nurses and the voluntary sector to a new level. In times of intense pressure on resources this is a new way of working that prioritises the most at risk clients and tailors services to their needs, to help them on the road to a better life with HIV.

It will particularly target those people who fall off the radar of hospital based clinics. Homeless people, those with problematic drug use and those unable to attend clinics for other reasons, such as severe mental health issues, face many more challenges managing their HIV and general health, when compared with peers.

As well as providing a stable home environment within one of the largest slums in the word (Kibera in Kenya) the children will also have access to the school, the feeding programme and the anti retroviral drugs needed to keep them stay healthy.

AIDS Orphan is a small UK based charity that improves the lives of children orphaned by HIV/AIDS by providing access to education, facilitating food security and ensuring the provision of life saving treatments and medication.

We work across the world to support and provide for children and infants who have been infected and affected by  $\rm HIV/AIDS$ .



"The Boys in the Band" is rightly regarded as a landmark piece in gay theatre, so it was a pleasure and a privilege for us all to appear in its return to the West End earlier this year.

On a chilly February afternoon, the postmatinee sweat was still clinging to us. With varying degrees of enthusiasm, we flung off our velvet jackets, paisley neckerchiefs and Vicuna sweaters, to pose on the set in our birthday suits. It was both liberating and hilarious. And that evening, we tried to put from our minds the fact that only a few hours previously, our colleagues' naked buttocks had been resting on that fetching green sofa. We hoped at least that their cheeks weren't too moist... Mart Crowley, who wrote "Boys" told us how the play seems to bring its cast together in a particular bond of friendship, and that's certainly been our experience. On our last night, as the party ended both onstage and off, and as both characters and actors said their farewells, there were moist cheeks all over again...

It's a tragic and sobering fact that of the original cast of "Boys", five of the nine actors died of AIDS related illnesses. Therefore we thought it was particularly fitting that our production should be supporting the fantastic work that the MAD Trust does. We're all proud to be involved and we hope very much that you enjoy the picture!
